Firstly, thank you for your prayers for my health. Despite covid, I was able to teach as soon as I recovered at the Biblical Institute and then was able to lead 2 trainings in the city of Antibes. I felt supported from above. Thank you, friends.

Here are some prayer subjects for the coming month:

« Breakfast foundation groups » for new disciples begin on Sunday, November 5 (another foundation group is scheduled for November 26). We have 3 people who have applied so far (Gustav, Yamina, Clara). Please pray for more registrations. A group of 7-8 would be ideal (these people attend our church: Jeannot and Cyrielle, Amin, Marie-Luce, Leila and possibly others).

Please continue to pray for Marlene, as there is a struggle between the Gospel and the Catholic tradition in her heart.

On November 5, Phil also has to preach on parenting during a service with the introduction of young children. A lot of non-Christian relatives are expected to come.

- On November 17th, on the occasion of the printing of his commentary on Genesis 1-11, Phil gives a conference/signing in Montélimar on the theme "Discovering our origins, understanding where we come from to know where we are going". Again, many non-Christian invited from the district around.
- On November 18, Phil leads, with a small committee, a regional meeting of 8 church councils on the topic of church planting and growth.
- On November 19, Phil preaches in Antibes (Riviera) to a church of more than 200 people. That same day and the following day, Phil and Marie-C have several meetings with male and female leaders of this church for training and mentorship. The goal is to start a training centre for church planters within a year.
- Please pray for Donovan, Joshua and Ben, young Christian workers, and student workers that Phil is training in Aix-en-Provence. Please pray for the ministry of Mary Christine, who is leading and training a group of several more advanced women in the faith in Aix so that they can care for other women in the church.
- Other projects:
 - Phil has been asked to write the second volume of his commentary. An English Edition is also on the process. Phil is also currently writing a French book on church planting (will be a GLO edition). We would like to also share with you the project (dream ?) to work with several Christian artists and musicians in order to promote Christian culture within the French speaking mindset. Could I ask you to pray for inspiration, wisdom, as well as special help, as this is again a completely pioneer work in this secular country called France ...
