

1. Pray for baby Janet as she has been very unwell



A). Leaders from Nyangombe led Sunday School and preached at the new church plant in Samuteba. There were over one hundred in the worship service and more than 70 children in Sunday School. The school room where the church meets was completely full.

B) The 2024 programme for the Bible School Teaching has already been sent out to all districts in a 300 square mile radius.

D) The cholera outbreak in Zambia will be contained and that pupils will be able to attend school again from 12th February 2024.

E) Than an initiative to distribute nets & reduce malaria, undertaken at Nyangombe, might have a significant impact on the 3,500 people under the care of our Clinic
